## Tour Itinerary

### DAY 1 : ARRIVAL IN JODHPUR

Check in at the hotel, then eat in the afternoon. In the afternoon, tour Jodhpur's most popular and well-maintained Mehrangarh Fort. The queens then built Jaswant Thada, also known as the Cenotaph of Maharaja, to honor their husbands. Lunch break after seeing the Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum. You may relax at the hotel or explore the area in the evening. Jodhpur hosts your night.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Jaswant Thada, Mehrangarh Fort, Umaid Bhawan Palace.



### DAY 2 : JODHPUR – JAISALMER TRANSFER (290 KMS/5 HRS)

Visit the Ramdevra Temple in Jaisalmer on your way there. Locals worship Baba Ramdev here because he is believed to be an avatar of Krishna. Here, at this spot, Lok Dev Baba Ramdev supposedly reached the living Samadhi. The common name for this spot is Runicha Dham. After that, go to Jaisalmer, where you spend the evening learning about the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971 at the Conflict Museum. Stay Jaisalmer at night.

**Monuments & Attractions :** War Museum, Ramdewara Temple.



### DAY 3 : JAISALMER – SAFARI IN THE THAR DESERT

The Jaisalmer Fort is a World Heritage Site and worthy of your time. Located on a small hill in India, this fort claims the title of “oldest inhabited fort in the world.” This impressive structure goes by a variety of titles, including Sonar Quila and the Golden Fort. This is a must visit among the tourist places in Rajasthan. Visit the Jain Temple, right in the middle of the fort, afterwards. The Salim Singh ki haveli is a beautiful and opulent haveli that was built in the 17th century by Salim Singh. Then, go to Nathmal Ji-ki-Haveli and Patwaon-Ki-Haveli. Drive on to Gadhisar Lake in the afternoon after lunch. Travel to the Thar Desert in the evening for a camel ride, optional ride in a vehicle, musical evening with folk dance, dinner, and a tent for the night.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Salim Singh ki haveli, Jaisalmer Fort, Camel Ride, Gadsisar Lake, Desert.

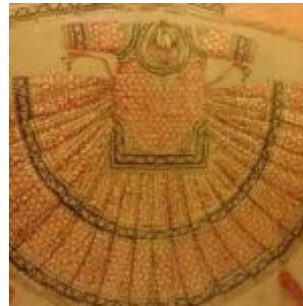


### DAY 4 : JAISALMER–BIKANER TRANSFER (330 KMS/6 HRS)

Drive to Bikaner, stopping for lunch. When you arrive in Bikaner, check into your hotel immediately. You may then visit Junagarh Fort (Bikaner Fort). Next, visit Bikaner Havelies and Sadul Singh Museum. Enjoy an evening of window shopping. Stay overnight in Bikaner.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Havelis, Sadul Singh Museum, Junagarh Fort.





## DAY 5 : BIKANER – JAIPUR TRANSFER (335 KMS/6 HRS)

After breakfast drive to Jaipur, one of the most essential tourist places in Rajasthan. Next, visit Albert Hall, Rajasthan's oldest museum, in Jaipur. Next, visit the Birla Temple at the foot of a hill. This work honors Bhagwan Laxmi Narayan. Moti Dungari Ganesh Temple, Jaipur's most respected Ganesha temple, is next. Your Jaipur hotel stay is overnight.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Birla Temple, Albert Hall, Ganesh Temple.



## DAY 6 : JAIPUR SITESEEING

The tour to the Pink City commences after breakfast at the renowned Hawa Mahal. After Hawa Mahal, proceed to the awe-inspiring Amber Fort. This is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Amber Fort showcases the grandeur of the Maharajas of the Amber. Now Sheesh Mahal is an essential attraction located within the Amber Fort. Among the Tourist places of Rajasthan these are the special places.

After visiting Amber Fort, give a visit also to Jal Mahal. This place is also referred to as "The Palace on Water." The next place to visit is Johari Bazaar, which is also a fine place for your lunch. After your lunch there, move to City Palace. It is a museum that showcases a collection of historical combat uniforms and garments worn by the royal family in previous eras.

The next destination for you is Jantar Mantar. This is known as the Observatory. This place holds the distinction of being an UNESCO World Heritage Site. It features a collection of authentic clocks and other instruments utilised for astronomical measurements. Your itinerary for the day ends here. After your tour for the day concludes, you stay at the hotel or have a pleasant evening at the nearby sites.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Hawa Mahal, Jal Mahal, Amber Fort, Jantar Mantar, City Palace.
