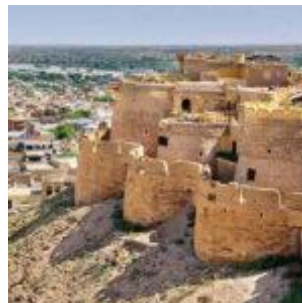

## Tour Itinerary

### DAY 1 : JAISALMER – ARRIVAL

Have Jaisalmer airport or train station pickup and short trip to hotel. We'll explore the 1971 Indo-Pakistani conflict, known as the Longewala conflict, as shown in Border this afternoon. Jaisalmer is a terrific overnight destination.

**Monuments & Attractions :** The great War Museum.



### DAY 2 : JAISALMER – THE THAR DESERT

Jaisalmer Fort is the UNESCO World Heritage Site. The world's oldest continually inhabited fort lies on a tiny hill in India. The beautiful Sonar Quila, Golden Fort, and others allude to the same building. Visit the fort's central Jain Temple afterward. Built in the 17th century but named after its owner, Salim Singh ki haveli is a wonderful haveli worth seeing. Next, visit Patwaon-Ki-Haveli and NathmalJikiHaveli. Lunch and drive to Gadasisar Lake in the afternoon. After visiting the Thar Desert by camel, jeep, or other vehicle, sleep beneath the stars in a tent. Dine and watch traditional music and dance.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Salim Singh ki haveli, Jaisalmer Fort, Desert, Gadsisar Lake, Camel Ride.



### **DAY 3 : JAISALMER – BIKANER TRANSFER (330 KMS/6 HRS)**

Travel to Bikaner after breakfast, stopping for lunch. After arriving in Bikaner, check into your accommodation. You should visit Junagarh (Bikaner Fort) later. See the Sadul Singh Museum and Bikaner Havelies thereafter. Enjoy a peaceful evening of window shopping. Stay in Bikaner overnight.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Havelis, Junagarh Fort, Sadul Singh Museum.



### **DAY 4 : BIKANER – JAIPUR TRANSFER (335 KMS/6 HRS)**

Check into a Jaipur hotel. Later, visit Albert Hall, the state's oldest museum. Visit the Birla Temple, dedicated to Lord Laxmi Narayan, at the foot of a small hill. Jaipur's holiest Lord Ganesha sanctuary is the Moti Dungari Ganesh Temple, next to the Birla Temple. Spend the night in Jaipur.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Albert Hall , Birla Temple , Ganesh Temple.



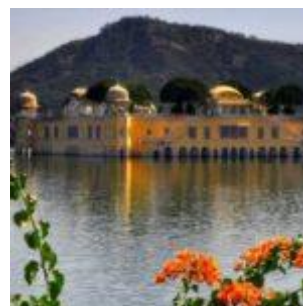
## DAY 5 : JAIPUR JAIPUR SITESEEING

The tour to the Pink City commences after breakfast at the renowned Hawa Mahal. After Hawa Mahal, proceed to the awe-inspiring Amber Fort. This is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Amber Fort showcases the grandeur of the Maharajas of the Amber. Now Sheesh Mahal is an essential attraction located within the Amber Fort. Among the Tourist places of Rajasthan these are the special places.

After visiting Amber Fort, give a visit also to Jal Mahal. This place is also referred to as "The Palace on Water." The next place to visit is Johari Bazaar, which is also a fine place for your lunch. After your lunch there, move to City Palace. It is a museum that showcases a collection of historical combat uniforms and garments worn by the royal family in previous eras.

The next destination for you is Jantar Mantar. This is known as the Observatory. This place holds the distinction of being an UNESCO World Heritage Site. It features a collection of authentic clocks and other instruments utilised for astronomical measurements. Your itinerary for the day ends here. After your tour for the day concludes, you stay at the hotel or have a pleasant evening at the nearby sites.

**Monuments & Attractions :** Hawa Mahal, Amber Fort, Jal Mahal, Jantar Mantar, City Palace.
