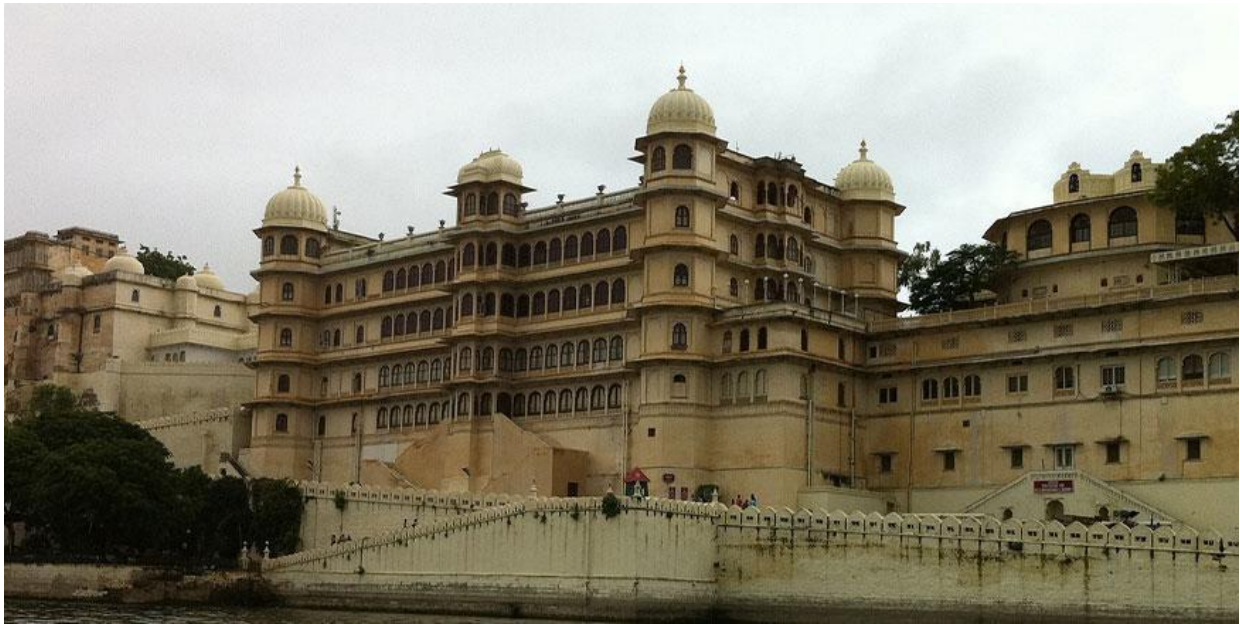

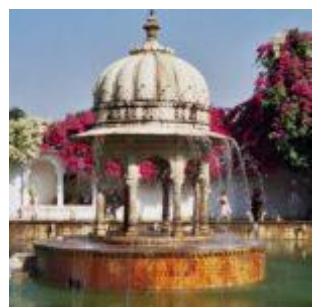
Monuments & Attractions : Fateh Sagar Lake, Pratap Smarak, Pichhola Lake.



DAY 2 : UDAIPUR SITESEEING

After you finish your meal, go over to the Jagdish Temple. Learn more about Rajputana's glorious past and fascinating culture by paying a visit to the City Palace. After that, chill out on Jag Mandir with a boat tour. After lunch, you may visit the beautiful Saheliyon-ki-Bari park, another popular tourist spot in Udaipur. You should spend the night in Udaipur and the evening at Bagorki Haveli. Among the Tourist places of Rajasthan this one is essential.

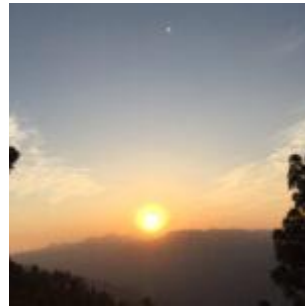
Monuments & Attractions : Jagdish Temple, Boat Ride, Bagorki Haveli, Saheliyon-ki -bari.



DAY 3 : UDAIPUR – MOUNT ABU TRANSFER

A trip to Mount Abu is in order. If you want to visit a hill station in Rajasthan, your only option is Mount Abu. Check out the Dilwara Jain temple, which is really a cluster of five different buildings dating back to the 1100s and 1300s. This beautiful temple honors the Jain religion and has statues of the faith's most revered leaders, the Tirthankars. Neminath, Adinath, Mahavir, and Parshvanath are just a few examples. Then, continue on to Mount Abu's ancient sacred Niki Lake. Spend the evening at Guru Shikhar's Sunset Point. In the Mount Abu region, Guru Shikhar stands tall as the tallest peak. Visit the Mount Abu region and stay the night.

Monuments & Attractions : Niki Lake, Dilwara Jain Temple, Sunset point (Guru Shikhar).



DAY 4 : MOUNT ABU – JAISALMER TRANSFER

Visit the Ramdevra Temple in Jaisalmer on your way there. Locals worship Baba Ramdev here because he is believed to be an avatar of Krishna. Here, at this spot, Lok Dev Baba Ramdev supposedly reached the living Samadhi. The common name for this spot is Runicha Dham. After that, go to Jaisalmer, where you spend the evening learning about the Indo-Pakistani War of 1971 at the Conflict Museum. Stay Jaisalmer at night. Among the Tourist places of Rajasthan you can find the right options right here.

Monuments & Attractions : War Museum, Ramdewara Temple.



DAY 5 : JAISALMER – THE THAR DESERT

The Jaisalmer Fort is a World Heritage Site and worthy of your time. Located on a small hill in India, this fort claims the title of “oldest inhabited fort in the world.” This impressive structure goes by a variety of titles, including Sonar Quila and the Golden Fort. This is a must visit among the tourist places in Rajasthan. Visit the Jain Temple, right in the middle of the fort, afterwards. The Salim Singh ki haveli is a beautiful and opulent haveli that was built in the 17th century by Salim Singh. Then, go to Nathmal Ji-ki-Haveli and Patwaon-Ki-Haveli. Drive on to Gadgisar Lake in the afternoon after lunch. Travel to the Thar Desert in the evening for a camel ride, optional ride in a vehicle, musical evening with folk dance, dinner, and a tent for the night.

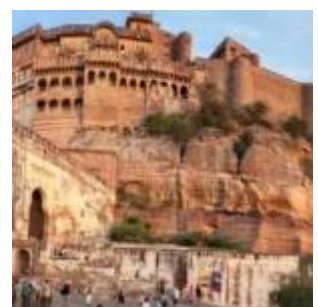
Monuments & Attractions : Salim Singh ki haveli, Jaisalmer Fort, Camel Ride, Gadsisar Lake, Desert.



DAY 6 : JAISALMER – JODHPUR TRANSFER

Travel to Jodhpur by automobile. After checking into the hotel, lunch is next. In the afternoon, tour Jodhpur’s most popular and well-maintained Mehrangarh Fort. The queens then built Jaswant Thada, also known as the Cenotaph of Maharaja, to honor their husbands. Later the day, visit Umaid Bhawan Palace Museum. You may relax at the hotel or explore the area in the evening. Jodhpur hosts your night.

Monuments & Attractions : Jaswant Thada, Mehrangarh Fort, Umaid Bhawan Palace.



DAY 7 : DEPARTURE FROM JODHPUR

Following breakfast, you will be transported to Jodhpur's airport or train station, where you may catch your onward journey.
